
Towards an ecological transition

Our aim is to strengthen the position of railways vis-à-vis other transport modes in order to reduce the carbon footprint of mobility (30% of GhG in France).

Railcoop also contributes to the **development of rural areas** (employment, industrialization).

Railcoop operates open access services

- Expected yearly turnover in the shortterm: €35m
- Revenue from tickets and onboard services (passengers), and freight
- No public operating subsidy
- Complementary with existing railway services, and with other means of transport (bike, local buses, carsharing)
- Main costs: track access charges, energy, rolling stock (including maintenance), wages (including train drivers)


